

Orion Park is a 25 acre Greenfield development site where clever use of vertical and horizontal cladding, together with subtle colour choice, has shown that large industrial warehouses can be designed with aesthetic appeal.

Colour and textures are an excellent way of breaking down scale. Feature bands within wall elevations are becoming more popular as designers see the benefits of reducing large surface areas of profiled cladding with colour and profile orientation.

Strategically located close to the A500, offering easy access to the M6 motorway, these four individual units comprise of over 2000m² of Quedron 1000/32C profile, finished in White, Goosewing Grey and Merlin Grey Corus Colorcoat HPS200 Ultra®.

The chosen inner lining was Quedron QLP19/1000 supplied in Bright White Lining Enamel.
